Here are some:



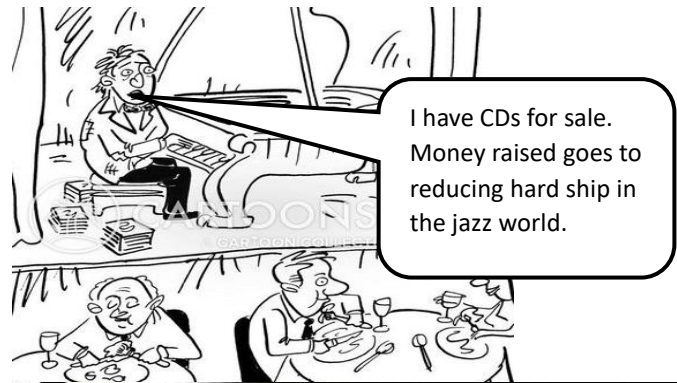
"Here's my business plan for the Jazz Store. I think we should just fake the budget, improvise the marketing and make up the long-range goals as we go along."

### Lounge Music is ...

Lounge music is a type of easy listening music popular in the 50s and 60s. It may be meant to evoke in the listeners the feeling of being in a place, usually with a tranquil theme, such as a rainforest, or an island paradise. The range of lounge music encompasses pleasant music. The earliest type of lounge music appeared during the 20s and 30s and was known as light music. While rock and roll was generally influenced by blues and country, lounge music was derived from jazz and other musical elements borrowed from traditions around the world.

Swing music of the era is also considered "lounge" and consisted of a continuation of the swing jazz era of the 30s and 40s, but with more of an emphasis on the vocalist - soft and gentle vocalists. Examples of lounge vocalists include Frank Sinatra and Dean Martin.

The music of Burt Bacharach featured as part of many lounge singers' repertoires. Artists performed mainly at featured lounges in Las Vegas casinos.
