PRESIDENT JULIE'S REPORT

Hi There Jazz Friends,

Well, after over 3 months of being good little people and doing as we have been told by the Government – and helping keep Queensland and Sunshine Coast COVID19 free – we are beginning to see some light at the end of the tunnel and some relaxing of restrictions. ALLELULAH!! However, restrictions dictate 1 person to 4 sqm of room space so we are reduced to 87 (including the band) Sadly, word came that the July show had to be cancelled as well as were the previous months of April, May and June. “Trombone Kellie & Muddy Roaders” were set to appear – **16 AUGUST 2020 – WHEN BORDERS WERE CLOSED AGAIN TO NSW and ACT!** Thankfully Russell Bayne & the Session Band (they had been cancelled for April so very excited to be coming after all!) were available to fill the last minute gap.

Where possible, I have been able to re-locate bookings to later dates – ie “The Andrews Sisters & Miller Horns” will now appear February 2021, “Pippa Wilson and her Queensland Swingtet”, are all set for November 2020 **DEPENDING ON VICTORIA!** (Because of restrictions on numbers permitted, which include the band numbers, Jindalee Jazz Orchestra will be re-located when the rules allow)

“HOT HOT HOT” from Mackay, North Queensland, will join us for an exclusive show in September and Caxton Street Jazz Band will return for our Christmas show, Gatsby style. (Best dressed prizes to be won!) We will have a **NEW LOCAL GROUP** in October – Simon Drew Sextet! (Simon appeared previously with Pete Kelly’s Interstate Swing Band)

Because we have had such strong ‘forward bookings’ for shows – being booked out 6 weeks in advance for August and looking that way for September, the Management Committee met and decided that rather than turn our loyal members and supporters away we would **TRIAL TWO SHOWS 20 SEPTEMBER**. Being mindful that many of you are not keen on night driving, we have made the times to suit – ie **FIRST SHOW** will begin **12 NOON – 2.30 PM** then the room will be vacated for cleaning and **SECOND SHOW** will begin **4 PM – 6.30 PM** – when it will still be light after.

We are delighted with the response to bookings – and subject to each band’s agreement we will continue two shows while our numbers are so restricted.

With these **LIMITS on numbers** to allow for ‘social distancing’ **we will require those wishing to attend to PRE-BOOK and PRE-PAY** – The permissible reduced numbers will not allow for us to fully cover our costs and will require a subsidy from Club funds, but we really want for **THE SHOW TO GO ON!** For you and for the entertainers! This is our main reason for requiring pre-bookings etc, as it would be very unfair if we had to turn people away when the cap was reached, only to have cancellations and spare seats. I am sure you will understand and be supportive of this move – we want to look after you, our treasured members & supporters.

Soooo looking forward to having you with us and enjoying jazz VERY SOON Julie

Peter Uppman, as always opens the afternoon with the Louis Prima "Just a Gigalo" which has the audience tapping their feet from the start, { Sure being a Gigalo is not Peter's daytime job??} Just Joking Peter! Several great solos from Kelsey Giarola a new member of the Session Band. Kelsey and Peter sang duets of several songs, to a pleasing audience. Greetings Jazz Lovers,

I hope everyone is keeping safe during these unprecedented times.

As most will know, these times have caused disruptions to the Sunshine Coast Jazz Club (SCJC) activities and events, but fortunately we will be back on track soon albeit in limited form due to social distancing requirements. These times have impacted on most facets of our lives and one facet of the SCJC that had to be postponed is the very commendable Youth 'n' Jazz Bursary until August / September 2021. Exact dates will be advertised as things become clearer. The Bursary was first created in 2019 for those talented youths on the Sunshine Coast who not only have a leaning towards Jazz and its elements, but also to encourage and support music awareness with total prize money of \$3000 to support those talents.

A SCJC philosophy is that "Youth are our Future" and that combined with the arts and fine music is a genuine approach by the club to support talented young artist and their respective schools. Included with the students Bursary prizes for both vocal and musical instrument sections are a further two prizes of five hundred dollars to that students school music department. Included with this experience is the unique and fun opportunity to perform with a professional Jazz Band.

However, this has not hindered the Bursary committee from moving forward and subsequently 33 letters and flyers were recently forwarded to Sunshine Coast Schools Principals to encourage involvement and to announce the SCJC incentives for schools.

The SCJC identified that this postponement will exclude those year twelve students who may have been looking forward to presenting their talents this year. Therefore, the committee voted to allow those year 12 students to be involved next year pending the submission of a 'Letter of Intent' prior to 30st November 2020 and then an application to be submitted by 31st March 2021. The SCJC website has all the information that interested persons will need, including the 'Letter of Intent' which will advise the SCJC committee of a pending application. Can I please call on all SCJC Members to spread the 'Bursary' word amongst family and friends especially as there are very handsome rewards for the winners and runners up.
