This well rehearsed orchestra set the afternoon standard with an updated arrangement of Miller's 'In The Mood'. Music from the Artie Shaw, Benny Goodman era with modern arrangements were well received. The "Pink Panther" theme was soundly applauded, charming vocalist TANYA then entertained with a bracket of songs including a beautiful version of Gershwin's "Summertime" and "An Orange Coloured Sky". The orchestra finished the first set with Nat Adderley's jazz classic "Work Song". The Orchestra played delightful arrangements of Billie Holiday's "God Bless The Child" and Sondheim's "Send in the Clowns" conducted by leader Bruce Barnet. TANYA returned with another enjoyable bracket including Paul Simon's "Bridge over Troubled Waters" and Julie London's "Cry Me a River". Several talented musicians were given great solo spots during the afternoon. The end was near and the Dizzy Gillespie "Night in Tunisia" had a large group of dancers struttin' their stuff. 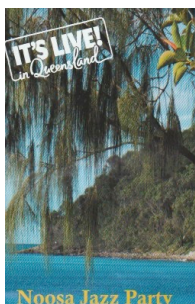
