YOUTH'N'JAZZ BURSARY 2021 – PRESENTATION

The Sunshine Coast Jazz Club believe that “Youth are our Future” and following a successful Youth ‘n’ Jazz Bursary in 2019 the club launched their second bursary to students in years 8 to 12 living and attending School in the Sunshine Coast Region, to encourage further studies (with an emphasis on jazz) and/or towards the purchase of musical instruments. The prize pool totals \$4,000 for both vocal and musical instrument sections and there are also a further two prizes of five hundred dollars (\$500) to the winner of each section for the student's school music department.

On Saturday 28th August, there will be eight aspiring young musicians who will experience the unique and fun opportunity to perform with a professional Jazz Band and in front of an appreciative audience. “Rick Best & The Day Trippers” will provide the backing with Rick Best on Keyboard; Dave Cox – Sax; Kevin Borlase – Bass and Pete Neville on Drums

The Presentation will be a fun afternoon, where families and friends are encouraged to participate and give their support and we hope many of our Club members will also attend to listen to the artists of the future. The presentation starts at 1.30pm at our usual venue – the Pelicans Room, Caloundra Power Boat Club, and tickets for this special event are: Family of up to 4 - \$20, Adults \$10, Students \$5.

The second set opened with a foot stompin' "Milenberg Joys" nice vocals from Bernice and Tom and a pleasant surprise oldie "South" from the Graeme Bell days. This brought great applause from the Victorians. Unfortunately, time stops all good things, so the afternoon finished with a Louis Prima fun song "I Wanna Walk Like You". Ben, our sound man makes sure the music is always at its best. We thank these very fine musicians for a relaxing, enjoyable toe tapping afternoon.

The Power Boat Club on Sunday 18th July was blown away by the opening from the great swinging BRISBANE BIG BAND. Compere/ vocalist, Alan Western, entertained with a bracket of swing and swaying songs including "I've Got You Under My Skin", "Skylark". The BBB played a superb "Round Midnight" a great jazz classic. Compere Al excited the audience as he introduced guest, the fabulous LYNN ROGERS. Lynn, smiling, laughing had the audience ready for her songs which included "The Best of Everything" "Embraceable You", "Lazy River" and the Casablanca favourite "As Time Goes By". Lynn & Al sang a saucy duet to finish the set.

The BBB blasted an original "South 21st Shuffle", Al, [always good to hear] followed with "Night & Day", "Georgia", the Joe Williams "Every Day I Have The Blues". A jazz standard, "Whisper Not", allowed the band to showcase great solos from some of these wonderful professional musicians we have in Brisbane. Time for LYNN - "On a Clear Day", "I am Woman", "Teach Me Tonight", the Sinatra "When I Was 17" nearly had the crowd in tears. What a performer - Style, grace, humour.!!!; A final fun duet from Alan & Lynn finished the fine afternoon. We also thank Ben our sound man who keeps the sound to perfection .

WILMA READING

Australian jazz legend Wilma Reading, a contemporary of Duke Ellington and Oscar Peterson, sang highlights from her dazzling international career as part of the Melbourne International Jazz Festival. Growing up in what she describes as the 'village' of Cairns in the 1950s, indigenous singer Wilma Reading was discovered performing at a Brisbane jazz club while on a school softball tour. This proved to be the catalyst for an international career that spanned the globe and recently saw her inducted into the National Indigenous Music Awards Hall of Fame and being interviewed on Richard Fidler's ABC "Conversation Hour". Highlights included performing with the Duke Ellington Orchestra, appearing on The Tonight Show with Johnny Carson, featuring at New York's Copacabana Night Club, starring on London's West End and rubbing shoulders with giants of jazz and US luminaries Ella Fitzgerald, Carmen McRae, Tony Bennett and Dave Brubeck.
