**What a really great year we have in store for you and January made a fabulous start to it, when we welcomed Brisbane Big Band and the lovely Melissa Western for a SOLD OUT show – with lots of newbies to our club, coming along as well. WOW! What a day it was and even though there were a few hiccups with the table plan being changed when it**

**was set up we managed. Thanks for your understanding.**

**It was a bit of a learning curve on the lead up to the January show, as you will know that Caloundra Power Boat Club event rooms – our normal monthly venue – were under-going some renovations which prevented anything being held there for at least 8 weeks. After visiting a number of other venues here at the coast, looking to find a suitable venue that could hold enough guests, we were lucky enough to get a booking for January and February 2023, at Pelican Waters Resort, in their ballroom and I thank Sinead and staff – especially Julia, for being so helpful and accommodating.**

**We now look forward to a change in pace with the beautiful and talented NICKI PARROTT – not just a pretty face (and body) she plays Double Bass, as well as delivering some very smooth vocals. The backing line-up is 'top shelf' with Rodney Ford- always a favourite - drums and vocals, Will Sargisson on keyboard (I hope he does a piano solo for us with those magic fingers), Tyler Cooney – First class Guitarist – and last but not least Shannon Marshall -Trumpet/Flugelhorn and vocals making a first appearance at our club – I am certain they won't disappoint. There are books on the Front of House table at the shows, for you to record your booking, call the jazz club number 0427 782 960 where credit card facility is available) OR for on line bookings payment can be done with bank transfers. (If you find trouble making an on- line booking, it may be that there are very limited seats still available for that show and you need to call the jazz line instead. **Please remember the shows are booking out much earlier with such great artists – and great value as the management committee strive to keep door price the same, even when the band is costing a lot more.** We also recognize that bands did it hard during COVID so we do all we can to pay full or above the going rate to ensure that we bring you the best of the best.**

**A reminder - The Club's year ends 31 December, and your membership needs to be renewed asap to enjoy Member benefits – we usually give you a little 'breathing space' until end January. Many took advantage of renewing before end December - Cost for renewing or new membership is now \$25 pp as per 2022 AGM. It is so pleasing to see so many applying to become new members of our club – thank you for your confidence in us.**

**We are always on the look- out for volunteers – this year especially, we are again losing a couple of our Management Committee due to family commitments or lifestyle change and travel. 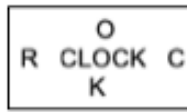

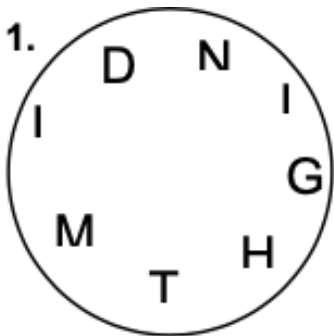

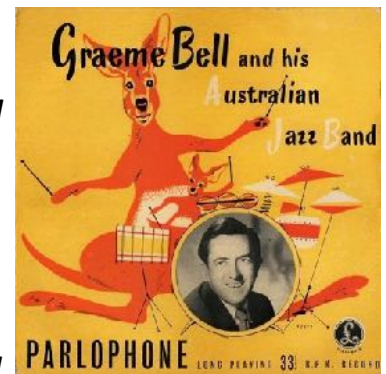
**(Solutions below)**

**Graeme Bell AO MBE (1914-2012)**

**Graeme Emerson Bell, 'The Father of Australian Jazz,' was born in Melbourne on 7 September 1914. Graeme was 11 when he began studying classical piano, but he was converted to jazz by his younger brother, trumpeter Roger.**

**The Youth League sponsored Bell's participation in the 1947 World Youth Festival in Prague.**

**As well as being a superb musician, he was an active member of the Australian jazz community who worked to raise the profile of Australian jazz. He created opportunities for jazz musicians to play, set up the Uptown Jazz Club and formed groups such as the Victorian Jazz Lovers Society.**



**Bell founded the jazz-oriented 'Swaggie' record label and toured for the ABC. In 1951 he made a 500-gig tour of Europe and the UK, during which he accompanied US blues singer Big Bill Broonzy and headlined a National Federation of Jazz Organisations gala at London's recently completed Festival Hall. Afterwards Bell was presented to HRH Princess Elizabeth, the future Queen.**

**The Australian jazz awards, which commenced in 2003, are named 'The Bell Awards' in his honour. In 2004 the Victorian Jazz Archive mounted a special exhibition to celebrate Bell's ninetieth birthday. The Archive holds a significant collection of Bell memorabilia, including photographs, instruments, clothing, posters, paintings and sound recordings.**

**In 2006 Live Performance Australia recognised Graeme Bell's life-long devotion to performing excellence with its James Cassius Williamson Award.**

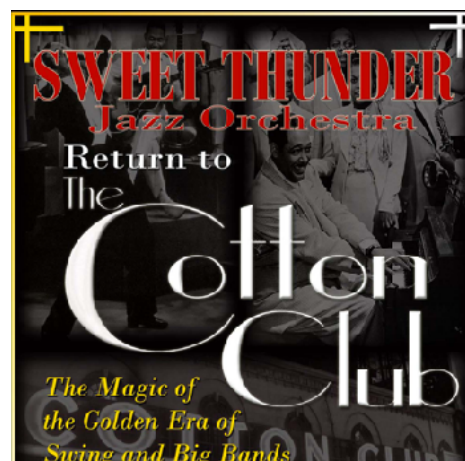
