## **President JULIE'S reports**

*Hi There Jazz Friends,*

**PRESIDENT JULIE'S ANNUAL REPORT - (As presented at the AGM 16 MAY 2021)**

*Good morning, and welcome to all, and thank you for your attendance today, for the Annual General Meeting of the Sunshine Coast Jazz Club Inc, year ended 31 December 2020.*

*The Management Committee for the year, has remained the same, with another 12 months at the helm, and I congratulate and thank them for a job well done and in helping to have the club negotiate what was a challenging year due to the COVID19 virus and restrictions placed upon one and all.*

*We have been able to bring and enjoy, some really great bands (Hot Hot Hot drove from Mackay to Caloundra, arriving Saturday night, performed 2 'sold out' shows Sunday, then drove back to Mackay Monday – 1200km and while their income wasn't great, said that they had a ball") Wal, our authorized club videographer, catches it all on camera – thanks so much Wal.*

*I am delighted to advise that our membership has continued to rise throughout the year, with applications for new membership at every show – the quality of jazz being in the fore front for this to happen, and we continue to aspire to our motto "Bringing the Best of the Best in Jazz". We weathered the virus 'storm' – losing 4 months of shows – and were still able to show a profit for the year ended.*

*We had the first show back after lockdowns in August, where we were restricted to 87 (including the band and volunteers) attendance, deciding that 'the show must go on'. Realizing this was not going to be viable financially and still pay the bands their usual fees, we decided to hold 2 shows each month on the third Sunday, which has proved very popular (maybe not so much with the hard working volunteers as it was a VERY LONG day – and the bands also found it very tiring – but enjoyable) and I thank all involved in making this possible, but now that we are able to increase our attendance numbers, as a trial, we have dropped back to one show per month.*

*Sadly, it was necessary to postpone our Student Bursary to 2021 when we hope to be able to foster rising talents in our youth once more. (If you know of any aspiring young musicians, please encourage them to check out our web site and apply – applications do close 30 June 2021 with total prize money on offer \$3,000.00. My thanks to Ray Hoeschler (Vice President and Bursary Committee) Trev Chalk, Jules Verity, Secretary Lyn Vanderwolf and PR/Media Pat Brennan, who have been working so hard to make this happen.*

*As you will recall, at our previous AGM it was agreed that we appoint for the first time, a Patron for the Club and our Founder and Life Member, Ted O'Connor (Red Sox) was given this honor. Due to ill health, we were not able to install Ted at a show, but he was delighted to be presented with a certificate while in hospital, displaying it with much pride at all times in his room there, and at the 'Assisted Living' Facility where he lived until his passing on 9 March. The management committee made the decision, that (with the permission of the family) the club would host a wake at the Power Boat Club following the service at*

*Gregson & Weight. Ted would have been so very proud to see the turnout of musicians who came from far and wide, members and friends, who dressed in bright colors (especially red), played jazz for him, in and out*

*of the Chapel, then to a guard of honor from the Chapel and to a fantastic Jazz jam session and many stories – one Member quoted “This is a \$100 ticket show!”*

*You may have noticed our new banners which were donated by Life Member Phil Benjamin – many thanks Phil – there have been others comment on the ‘correction’!*

*Our Treasurer, Fran Kosenko, is doing a fabulous job looking after the money and books as you will see when you read her Financial Report for the year and know that she makes sure we are all in line with any spending while Lyn Vanderwolf is not only Secretary but now looks after the Membership Register while keeping an eye on the web bookings. Jules of course, does a great job with our web site – with the assistance of ‘web master’ Gerald (what a gem!) If you haven’t already done so, please check out the web site as a lot of work has gone into making it first class.*

*Richard, “Bookings and Front of House Manager”, has had his hands full with two shows and forward bookings, but keeps on smiling – he runs a tight ship with his rosters for the wonderful volunteers – Meredith, Fran, Janey Baby (who must be the best raffle ticket seller around!) Pat on photography. My husband, John puts in a long day with setting up before each show, then looking after ‘sign in’ at the door, to be assisted by Ray, Bridie, Lyn and Bob – Lyn Weston & myself. My admiration and thanks to each and every one of you for jobs well done and my thanks to wives and partners who continue to support you and the club.*

*My special thanks goes to the Power Boat Club Management and staff – especially Priscilla and Susie – and to those staff who find their way to your table with your meal – sometimes when a wrong name or number has been given! You are very much appreciated.*

*I again thank the bands and Ben our sound man, for their friendship and wonderful shows, and in advance for the coming shows, **but mostly, I thank you, the Members, for your continued support and encouragement** – for your willingness to help out if necessary and participation in our themed days where it is so good to see so many dress up. My congratulations to the newly elected committee for 2021 and look forward to more great jazz with you.*
