A tribute to Queen Elizabeth II



It is a very sad day with the passing of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II.

The Queen served the Commonwealth for 70 years – the longest serving British Monarch and second in history to the 72-year reign by Louis XIV of France.

A truly remarkable, selfless woman. It is true to say, she is absolutely irreplaceable.

She has shown great determination and strength through difficult times – both personally and in her capacity as Monarch.

In June 1953, she was officially crowned Queen of England. During her reign, she was Australia's head of State during the service of 16 Australian Prime Ministers and 16 Governors-General of Australia.

On Sunday 21st August the PowerBoat Club was "All shook up" by the TROMBONE KELLIE GANG!! Scrubby Pete opened the set with "I Ain't Got You". A relaxed "Morning Train" was then followed by blues greats BB King, Chuck Berry and the blues master Joe Turner. Kellie gave her gut bustin' Trombone and great blues voice plenty of opportunity to let us know she is the boss, the best at what this group does. "Honeysuckle Rose", "Goodie Goodie" and "It Won't Be Long" were forerunners to Pete's slide guitar version of "Can You Be Satisfied". A slow blues featuring Vonnie on tenor finished the set. A brief break then a wild Elvis "You Ain't Nothin But a Hounddog" from Kellie sat us back ready for another great blues and Rock session. Not disappointed, Justin on bass just keeps on slappin' and pluckin' that steady solid beat with Tony on drums, add Pete's authentic guitar and you have the perfect ryhtym section for Kellie to surround us with that great powerful voice. Von was featured again with a lovely tenor solo on "Lonely Avenue". Ellington was not forgotten with "It Don't Mean a Thing". All afternoons must end and a very appreciative audience gave TROMBONE KELLIE GANG the best - an upstanding ovation.

Whizz, Bang etc LYNN came on stage and told everyone 'I am here to entertain' and did she not!! Song after song. The Duke's 'Don't Get Around Much Anymore', 'When or When' and the beautiful ballad 'The Nearest of You' then a life story 'Ten good Years'. Lynn often sings the verse which tells the story of the song. Lynn sings many verses. Another beautiful ballad 'I Saw You'. Errol Garner's 'Misty' had a few eyes watering and the set finished with 'It's Alright With Me' and it was certainly alright with the audience. Set 2 opened with Rodney and the superb musicians doing a more than credible version of 'Moon Dance'. A surprise, a member of the audience joined Lynn for a duet of 'In Other Words'. The Chet Baker Story

Chesney Henry "Chet" Baker Jr (1929 – 1988) was an American jazz trumpeter and vocalist, known for major innovations in cool jazz that led him to be nicknamed the "Prince of Cool". Baker earned much attention and critical praise through the 1950s, particularly for albums featuring his vocals. Jazz historian, Dave Gelly, described the promise of Baker's early career as James Dean, Sinatra and Bix rolled into one. His well-publicized drug habit also drove his notoriety and fame. Baker was frequently in and out of jail before enjoying a career resurgence in the late 1970s and 1980s. When his body was found, crumpled and bloodied, on an Amsterdam pavement on 13 May 1988, beneath the third-floor window of the hotel where he was staying, at first no one recognized him. Years of drugs and alcohol abuse had rendered the 58-year-old unrecognizable from the clean-cut young man who, in the early 50s, with his chiselled good looks, was perceived as the iconic poster boy for West Coast cool jazz. Though Baker's death was officially deemed to have been a tragic accident that resulted from him falling from his hotel window, the singing trumpeter's demise was an ignominious one for a jazz musician whose career had begun so spectacularly
